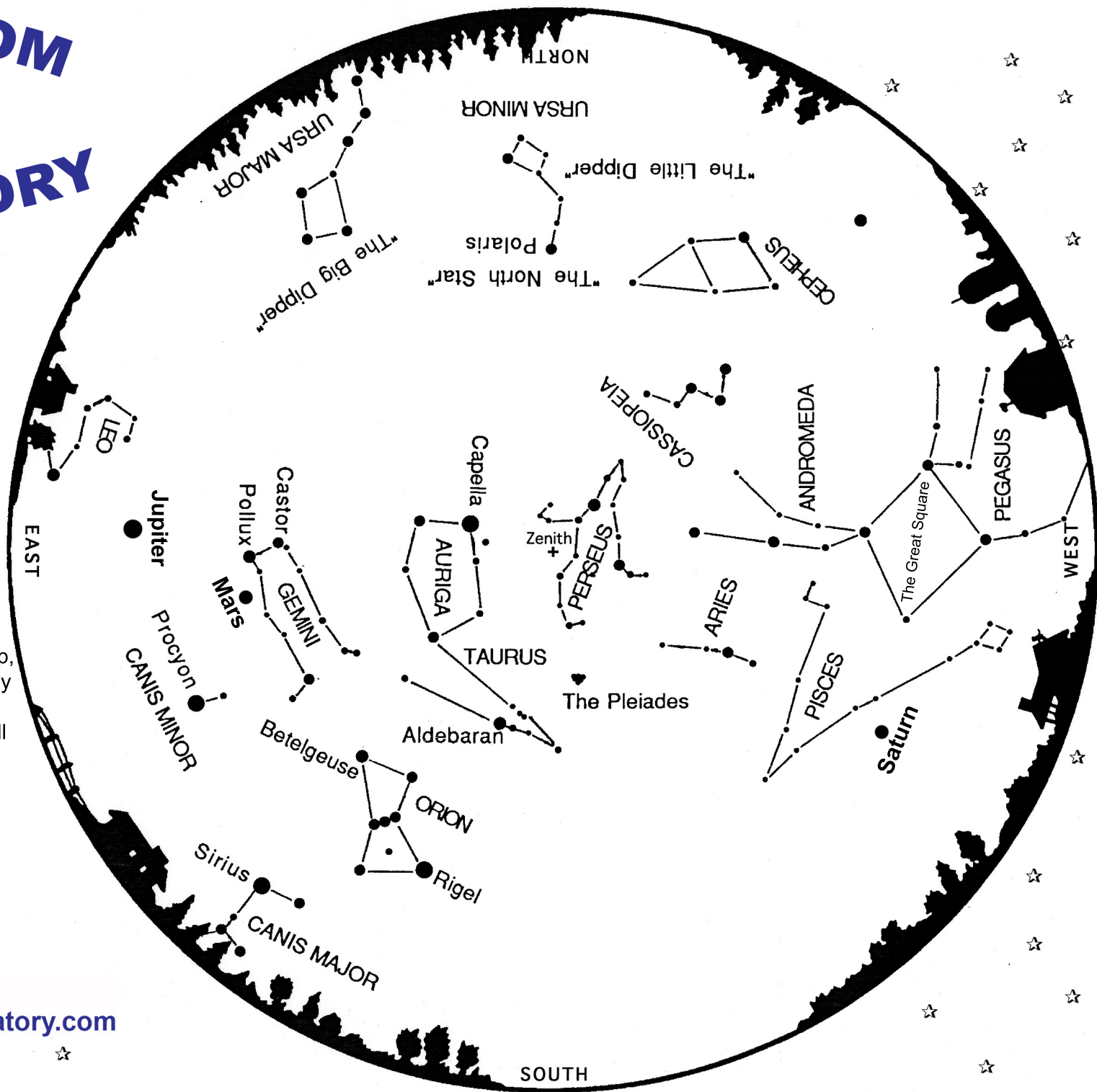
Morning Sky

1 hour before sunrise
at midmonth

The star map is drawn for 43-degrees north latitude, but is useful for other nearby latitudes. Planet positions are shown for mid-month.

TO USE STAR MAP:

Hold map in front of you so that the direction you are facing is at the bottom. The center of the map, the zenith, marks the point directly overhead. The position of the constellations on the star map will match the night sky.
